



Chicano Park San Diego, California

Construction Instructions

Here are all the tools you need to create Chicano Park. All you really need is glue & scissors. I prefer hot glue, but this can be hazardous around smaller children. If this is the case, I recommend ordinary white glue. I also use a straight edge and a dry pen for scoring the fold lines. I highly recommend scoring the fold lines.



Step 1. Cut out all of the parts. Cut along the perimeter black lines.



Step 2. Score along all of the dashed fold lines on all pieces.

Step 3. Locate the picnic table and assemble as shown. Fold the table and seats back over and place a drop of glue on the tabs.



Step 4. Lay out the column parts and dry fit them to familiarize yourself with how they fit together. Apply glue to the white tabs and glue each side piece to the back of the column. Be careful to glue the side to the correct back as the tops of the columns slope and the back is shorter than the front.



Step 5. Once the sides are glued to the back of the column, apply glue to the tab, one at a time, and glue the front of the column in place.



Step 6. Repeat for the remaining column.




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Step 7. Next, we build the Coronado Bridge. Locate the the top and bottom bridge deck sections. The top or road section is the one with the double yellow lines. Fold them to fit the shape of the bridge ends. The top being mainly flat with the side walls and the underside with the two beams.



Step 8. Glue the top section to one of the end pieces, folding as you glue. Glue the remaining end section. Complete the bridge section by gluing the bottom portion to the two ends and top.



Step 9. Locate all of the assembled parts as shown. Glue the two columns in place, but be careful to glue the correct column in the correct square, facing the correct way.




In the picture shown, the back of the park is to the right. That means the short column is glued on the right with the slope down to the right.

The taller column is glued to the square on the left with the slope to the right. This way the bridge section will glue to the tops of the columns evenly.

Step 10. Glue the side and end wall to the bridge section as show. Glue the walls to each other.


Step 11. Now, apply some glue to the tops of each of the two columns and to the bottoms of each of the walls. Position the bridge / wall section over the columns, align, press into place, and hold until the glue is dry.



Let's build the Optional Park Kiosk!

Step 12. This is optional. Locate the remaining Kiosk parts. Fold the ends of the Kiosk center floor as shown and glue.

Step 13. Fold and glue the Kiosk main floor corners as shown. Also, fold the inside tabs, down.






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
Step 14. Glue the Kiosk center floor to the opening in the main floor as shown.

Step 15. Next, glue the strips as shown, to the bottom of the Kiosk floor assembly. This keeps it square and holds the ramps in place.




Step 16. Fold the Kiosk roof and glue the corners in place. Next, glue the 4 Kiosk legs to the Kiosk roof. Be sure to glue them on an angle as shown.

Step 17. Now, glue the 4 legs of the Kiosk to a base of scrap card stock as shown. Complete the Kiosk assembly by gluing to a piece of card stock, light cardboard, or foam core.



Step 18. Last step! Assemble the trash can by rolling the cut out and gluing the tab to form a cylinder. Glue the trash can lid tabs in place. When complete, glue your trash can into the park as shown.



Your Chicano Park is now complete! Enjoy!
